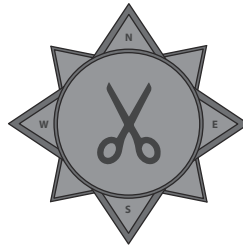


USING GIFT BAGS

TASK 2

For this you'll need an appropriate sized gift bag, some different colored tissue paper, and some ribbon would be nice, along with a gift tag.

1. Open up each piece of tissue and lay it flat on a table, be careful not to tear it. You will use this to add volume to the bag as well as hiding the gift, so there is still some unwrapping to do.

2. Push the center of one of the pieces of tissue paper into the bag so that it creates a pocket to place the gift into. Doing this with several pieces, especially if they are different colors, can look really nice.

3. Place the gift inside the bag. Make sure you place it inside the center pocket created by the tissue paper. Be careful you don't simply crush the tissue paper down to the bottom. This will be tough if your bag is too small.

4. Now, bunch the tissue paper neatly over the gift, so the gift can't be seen.

5. Add the gift tag and any ribbons
